

Leticia is just in the middle between Santa Rosa (Peru) and Tabatinga (Brasil). There are several ways to travel from Iquitos or Manaus to Leticia by plane, fast or slow boats. Immigration paper work is really important in this area but don't miss confuse just because we are an open boundary, you will get a 400 USD fine if you play with it. On each city (Tabatinga-Santa Rosa-Leticia) there is an immigration office so you can do your paper work right without any problem and remember that is **free**.

Dude, if you do an exit stamp from any country (Peru-Colombia-Brasil), you must do an entry stamp the next 24 hr. If you stay longer without any entry stamp, you will get a 400 USD international fine. It's not a joke.

Exit stamp from Santa Rosa (Peru) and entry stamp to Leticia (Colombia)

This process is really simple and we have to divided by boat and plane.

Plane: If you come by the Monday and Friday plane leaving from Iquitos Airport and arriving to Leticia's Airport. You need to go to Leticia's airport immigration office and do your paper work.

Boat: It doesn't matter if you take a fast or slow boat, it will be the same process. In Santa Rosa, there is an Immigration office so you can do the exit stamp and then take a boat to Leticia Amazonas (3,000 COP per person), go directly to Leticia's Airport immigration office and do the Colombian entry stamp.

- **Colombian Immigration Office in Leticia's airport opens from 8:00 Am to 6:00 PM everyday.**
- **Santa Rosa Immigration office is always someone living there, knock the door and wait until they open.**

Exit stamp from Santa Rosa (Peru) and entry stamp to Tabatinga (Brasil)

The same as in entering to Colombia, we will divided by boat and plane.

Plane: If you come by the Monday and Friday plane leaving from Iquitos Airport and arriving to Leticia's Airport. You need to go to Tabatinga Federal Immigration office and do your paper work but **before that you will have to go to Leticia's Immigration Airport office to do an entry and exit stamp from Colombia.**

Boat: It doesn't matter if you take a fast or slow boat, it will be the same process. In Santa Rosa, there is an Immigration office so you can do the exit stamp and then take a boat to Tabatinga (Brasil) (3,000 COP per person), go directly to Tabatinga Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian entry stamp.

- **Tabatinga Federal Immigration office opens everyday from 7:00 Am to 12:00 Am and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.**

Exit stamp from Leticia (Colombia) and entry stamp to Tabatinga (Brasil)

Here the only way to travel to Leticia is by plane.

Plane: There are only 2 flights to Leticia everyday. When you arrive to Leticia Amazonas, go to the Immigration office at the airport and do the exit stamp. After you have done it, visit Tabatinga's Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian entry stamp.

- **Tabatinga Federal Immigration office opens everyday from 7:00 Am to 12:00 Am and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.**
- **Colombian Immigration Office in Leticia's airport opens from 8:00 Am to 6:00 PM everyday.**

Exit stamp from Leticia (Colombia) and entry stamp to Santa Rosa Peru (Tabatinga)

In Leticia Amazonas, the only way to travel to Leticia is by plane.

Plane: There are only 2 flights to Leticia everyday. When you arrive to Leticia Amazonas, go to the Immigration office at the airport and do the exit stamp. After you have done it, visit Tabatinga's Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian entry stamp.

- **Tabatinga Federal Immigration office opens everyday from 7:00 Am to 12:00 Am and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.**
- **Santa Rosa Immigration office is always someone living there, knock the door and wait until they open.**

Exit stamp from Tabatinga (Brasil) and entry stamp to Leticia (Colombia)

There are only 2 ways to travel from Brasil to Colombia.

Plane: There is only one airline company that flights Manaus - Tabatinga. When you arrive to Tabatinga (Brasil), go to Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian exit stamp. After you have done it, go to the Immigration office at Leticia's airport and do the entry stamp.

Boat: Is the same process if you arrive on a fast boat or ferry from Manaus. When you arrive to Tabatinga (Brasil), go to Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian exit stamp. After you have done it, go to the Immigration office at Leticia's airport and do the entry stamp.

- **Tabatinga Federal Immigration office opens everyday from 7:00 Am to 12:00 Am and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.**
- **Santa Rosa Immigration office is always someone living there, knock the door and wait until they open.**

Exit stamp from Tabatinga (Brasil) and entry stamp to Santa

Rosa (Peru)

There are only 2 ways to travel from Brasil to Colombia.

Plane: There is only one airline company that flights Manaus - Tabatinga. When you arrive to Tabatinga (Brasil), go to Federal Immigration office and do the Brazilian exit stamp. After you have done it, go to Tabatinga's port, take a boat to Santa Rosa (Peru - The price is 3 R per person) and go to Santa Rosa Immigration Office to do the entry stamp

Tabatinga Federal Immigration office opens everyday from 7:00 Am to 12:00 Am and from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

Santa Rosa Immigration office is always someone living there, knock the door and wait until they open.
